On 09/24/2022 at 0731 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a shooting.

I arrived at the intersection of Westview and Highland and met with Dep. J. Patella who advised me that he needed assistance securing the scene with crime scene tape. I then began a contamination log of who entered the scene at the request of Dep J. Gnesin.

I spoke to the complainant, Dayna M Purcell, who advised that she heard a single gunshot in the roadway outside of her house. When she exited the house, a subject, who she identified as "Dave" (unkown last name), advised her to call the police.

Per Sgt Surran I released the scene back to Dep J Patella and relocated to the secondary scene at [REDACTED] and relieved Sgt Leavitt.

I had no involvement other than what is detailed in this report.
