## OfficerID: 1861, Narrative

### SYNOPSIS

I was dispatched to 322 N Orange Ave, on 02/13/2023, at 1418 hours regarding a fight in progress.

### LOCATION / SCENE DESCRIPTION

322 N Orange Ave (Quick Stop Food Stores)

### STATEMENTS

Victim - [REDACTED] - Stated that as she arrived to work at the above address. There was a white female wearing a purple sweater, wrapped in a purple comforter laying in the parking lot. The female was later identified as Melissa Vandyke. [REDACTED] advised Vandyke that she could not lay down there and asked her to move. Vandyke stood up, walked to the sidewalk by the front entrance and laid down again. [REDACTED] told Vandyke that she needed to leave the area. Vandyke then told her she needed something to drink but had no money. [REDACTED] asked Vandyke to leave the area. Vandyke then stood up and attempted to go inside the business past [REDACTED] Vandyke attempted to move [REDACTED] from the entrance way by pushing into her with her shoulder. [REDACTED] stated that Vandyke struck her so hard that she almost fell over. After advising Vandyke that the police were going to be called, Vandyke began to leave the business. [REDACTED] stated that she wished to prosecute for the battery.

Suspect - Melissa Vandyke - Vandyke stated that she just wanted to use the ATM and [REDACTED] would not allow her inside the business. Vandyke stated that there was no physical altercation at all. Vandyke stated she never touched [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] never touched her.

### INVESTIGATION / CANVAS / EVIDENCE

I arrived on scene and made contact with the above mentioned parties. There were no visible injuries on [REDACTED], she did not require medical attention after the incident. Vandyke returned to the property parking lot after law enforcement arrived on scene. [REDACTED] verified that Vandyke was the subject who had battered her. Security footage of the incident corroborates [REDACTED] version of the incident. Footage was uploaded via Axon Capture. Vandyke was issued a Notice to Appear for FSS 784.03(1)(a)(1) Simple Battery. I advised Vandyke that signing the Notice to Appear was not an admission of guilt, only stating that she would attend her mandatory court date on 03/07/2023. Vandyke stated that she understood, signed the Notice to Appear and was issued her yellow copy. Vandyke left the property on foot without further incident. Due to the violent nature of the crime and her arrest history, Vandyke does not meet criteria for APAD.

### CASE DISPOSITION / CRIME ELEMENTS

[REDACTED] was issued a Marsy's Law Pamphlet, Victims Rights Brochure and a Victim Notification card. Case closed/inactivated.
