NARRATIVE

On 7-30-24, I was called out to assist with a shooting at [REDACTED] 29th St. The rear window of this residence had 5 holes in it. Located a short distance away from this window, in the back yard of [REDACTED] 29th St, were seven 40 caliber shell casings were found. One juvenile male, Elijah Battie (16 yo) was transported to Sarasota Memorial Hospital with gunshot wounds.

Elijah's was asleep in his bed in his bedroom. His bedroom window was the window that was shot. His bed sits against the window and is just about flush to the window sill. When the bullets entered the window, they struck Elijah while he was sleeping. Elijah has 3 gunshot wounds to the right leg and 1 gunshot wound to the left leg. The left leg gunshot wound shattered his femur, and he was taken to emergency surgery.

Elijah's family advised that whoever shot at Elijah was at [REDACTED] 29th St. Officers searched the residence for suspects and cleared the house of the occupants. Inside the residence was Fatima Williams (11-1-87), her 3 year old daughter, and her son's friend Antorri Smith. Fatima's 14 yo son Jaylon Williams was not home at the time.

When I arrived on scene, Antorri was sitting on the curb outside the residence not in handcuffs. Officer Hughes transported Antorri to SPD at my direction for an interview. Fatima remained on scene at a neighbors house, while officers secured the house. Fatima supplied officers with surveillance camera footage, of a couple of camera views, from inside and outside her residence. Below is a timeline of the video footage:

4:44am- Antorri sits in chair in front of monitor in hoodie/shorts
 4:48am- Antorri gets up from chair, puts something in waist (appears to be a gun). Goes around corner towards the bedrooms
 4:50am- Antorri walks around goes out of view of camera
 4:52am- Antorri walking outside of house by door
 4:58am- Antorri walks inside the kitchen and watches his hands
 5:00am- Antorri is in living room blowing up air mattress
 5:03am- Antorri gets up from air mattress, meets Fatima in kitchen and he hands her a bag of an unknown contents. She walks towards the bedrooms with bag.

Officer Hughes sat with Antorri, in the interview room, until the audio/video recorded interview started.

I contacted Antorri's mother, Peggy Pittman, by phone and asked her to meet us at the police station to sit with Antorri while we interviewed him. She agreed and met us at SPD. She was present for interview.

NARRATIVE CONTINUED

I read Antorri his Miranda Rights, reading it one line at a time having him explain each line in his own words back to me. If he did not understand I explained in detail what it meant. Antorri and his mother were both offered food, drink, and bathroom breaks repeatedly through the interview.

Initially Antorri was not forthcoming about the incident.

Based on the video surveillance, social media posts, and victim family statements probable cause was established for a residential search warrant at 2923 Gillespie Ave (Fatima's house). Once the search warrant was signed by a judge, the search warrant was executed on the residence. Inside the residence 2 guns were located, 1 gun (9 mm) in Fatima's bedroom under a pillow on the bed, and another gun was located in the bottom dresser drawer in Jaylon's bedroom under some clothes. This gun was a .40 caliber with an extended clip. Also located in the residence was a large bag of marijuana located in a duffel bag in Fatima's bedroom.

Detective Laster and I spoke with the victim's grandmother inside their residence at [REDACTED] 29th St. She showed us Elijah's bedroom where the shots entered the window. She said also sleeping in the room, in the bed next to Elijah's bed, was her 14 year old grandson Geroy. Geroy was not hit by any bullets because he was sleeping more towards the top of his bed. There were holes in the wall above Geroy's bed. They do not know if these holes were already there or if they were from the bullets. All holes in the house to include the ones on the wall were photographed by criminalistics.

After we finished the search warrant at this residence, Detective Laster and I came back to SPD to speak with Antorri and his mother about what was found in the residence. I read Miranda again the same way to Antorri and he agreed to continue to speak with us.

These actions are in line with the video surveillance provided by Fatima.

NARRATIVE

Detective Laster and I conducted an audio recorded interview with Fatima in Detective Laster's unmarked patrol car. She stated her son Jaylon left her house to go to her mother's house around 930pm the night before. She said he has not been home since then, and has been at her mother's house the entire time. Fatima said Antorri came to her house to visit Jaylon and then fell asleep and she didn't want to wake him and make him go out late to get home alone. She heard the shots and they were close. She said she called 911. She was not aware that Antorri had anything to do with the shooting.

Fatima mentioned the burglary that occurred while they were on vacation. She said nothing was taken but the house was ransacked.

Antorri was handcuffed and arrested for attempted murder with a firearm.

Antorri Smith admitted to shooting a firearm through the victim's window subsequently striking him multiple times. Probable cause exists to charge Antorri Smith with Attempted Murder with a Firearm.

NARRATIVE

At 0457 hours, on 7/30/24, Elijah Battie was the victim of a shooting while inside his residence at [REDACTED] 29th Street. The shots came through Battie's bedroom window. Battie was shot four times and transported to Sarasota Memorial Hospital. Battie believed the shooter was Jaylon Williams who resides at 2923 Gillespie Ave.

Officers made contact with Fatima Williams who resides at 2923 Gillespie Ave. Williams gave officers access to security camera footage she had from several security cameras inside and outside of her residence.

Based on the security footage reviewed by Detective Wicinski, Det. Coppinger requested a residential search warrant for 2923 Gillespie Ave. This search warrant was signed by Judge Padar.

During the execution of the search warrant, a large vacuum-sealable bag (not currently vacuumed sealed), was located in a bedroom at the end of a hallway on the left. The approximate weight of the narcotics is 12.66 Ounces of leaf Marijuana. Along with the marijuana, a digital scale and packaging materials were also found.

Based on my training and experience as a narcotics detective, this is a very large quantity of marijuana and not an amount that would be possessed for personal use. Street-level narcotics dealers often purchase marijuana by the pound (16 ounces) and then distribute smaller quantities. This is consistent with the scale and packaging materials that were also found. Possessing this quantity of marijuana is typical of someone who intends to distribute the narcotics to a narcotics user. The residence where the narcotics were located is within 1000 feet of Trinity Missionary Baptist Church, located at 1947 31st Street.

In the same bedroom where the narcotics were located, detectives also located a loaded (with a round in the chamber) 9mm Taurus (S/N ABA241193) handgun on a bed, under a pillow.

Inside the same bedroom, detectives located the social security card and Fatima Williams' driver's license.

A second firearm was found in a bedroom across the hall, an unloaded Glock 27, .40 caliber (S/N

Fatima's two sons, Jaylon Williams (16 years old), Marion Williams (12 years old) and her daughter, Arionna Green (3 years old) also reside there.

During an interview (recorded and placed in evidence.com) with Fatima Williams, F Williams admitted knowledge of the Taurus firearm as well as the marijuana.

Based on the information above, Fatima Williams has knowingly and willfully placed her children in a residence where a loaded and unsecured firearm was present. Fatima Williams is being charged with Possession of Marijuana with intent to distribute within 1000 feet of a church as well as possession of drug paraphernalia. Williams is also being charged with neglect of a child without great bodily harm.

These crimes occurred in the City of Sarasota, FL.

NARRATIVE

At 0457 hours, on 7/30/24, Elijah Battie was the victim of a shooting while inside his residence at [REDACTED] 29th Street. The shots came through Battie's bedroom window. Battie was shot four times and transported to Sarasota Memorial Hospital. Battie believed the shooter was Jaylon Williams who resides at 2923 Gillespie Ave.

Officers made contact with Fatima Williams who resides at 2923 Gillespie Ave. Williams gave officers access to security camera footage she had from several security cameras inside and outside of her residence.

Based on the security footage reviewed by Detective Wicinski, Det. Coppinger requested a residential search warrant for 2923 Gillespie Ave. This search warrant was signed by Judge Padar.

During the execution of the search warrant, a large vacuum-sealable bag (not currently vacuumed sealed), was located in a bedroom at the end of a hallway on the left. The approximate weight of the narcotics is 12.66 Ounces of leaf Marijuana. Along with the marijuana, a digital scale and packaging materials were also found.

Based on my training and experience as a narcotics detective, this is a very large quantity of marijuana and not an amount that would be possessed for personal use. Street-level narcotics dealers often purchase marijuana by the pound (16 ounces) and then distribute smaller quantities. This is consistent with the scale and packaging materials that were also found. Possessing this quantity of marijuana is typical of someone who intends to distribute the narcotics to a narcotics user. The residence where the narcotics were located is within 1000 feet of Trinity Missionary Baptist Church, located at 1947 31st Street.

Jaylon Williams was transported to the Sarasota Police department and interview by Det. Kim Laster and Det. Jessica Sullivan in reference to the shooting.

After being advised of his miranda rights, Jaylon Williams agreed to speak with the detectives.

During the course of the interview, Jaylon Williams insisted to the detectives the marijuana was his.
